Novelist is the perfect source for finding that next great read.

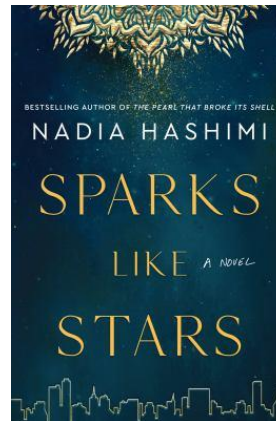
