

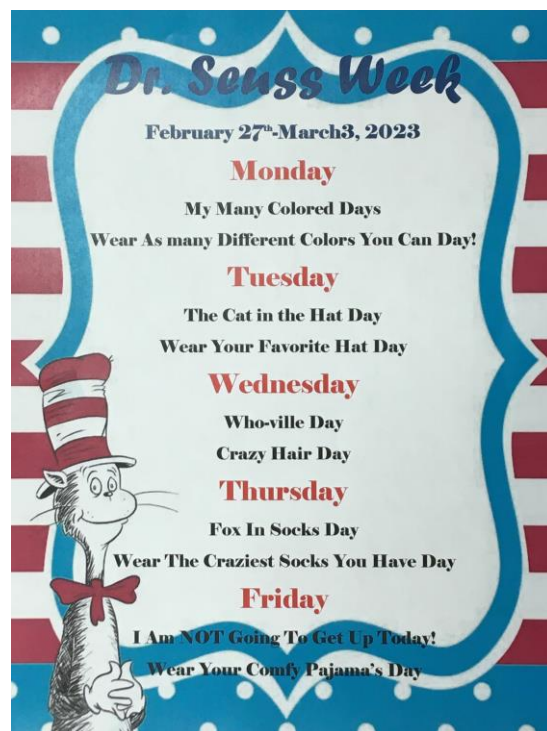
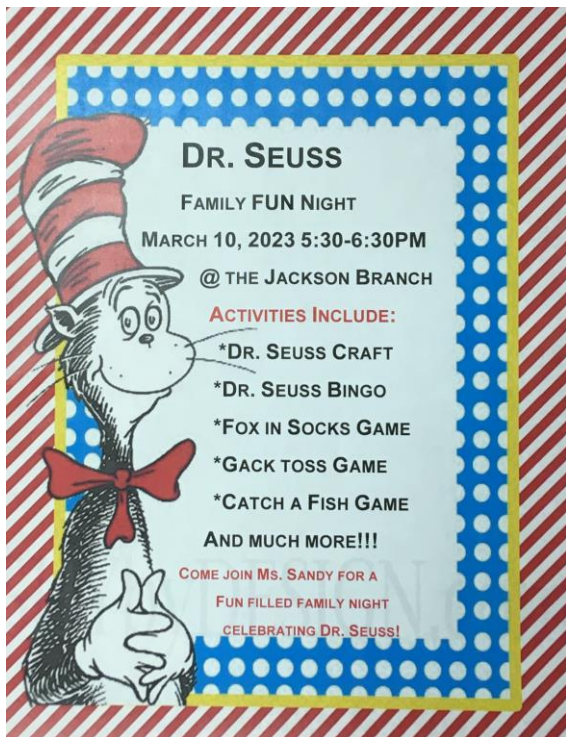

If you've done any genealogy research, then you're probably familiar with Ancestry. But did you know that you can access Ancestry for free through the library? This database holds millions of census, marriage, birth, death, military and other records. Ancestry is available in the library only.

HeritageQuest

Heritage Quest is a database similar to Ancestry (by Ancestry). While it doesn't have as many records as Ancestry, you can access it from home through the Library's website with your library card and PIN.



The Missouri State Library and State Historical Society of Missouri websites also have resources helpful for genealogy research such as death records. Of particular interest is the Newspaper Digitization Project, which is searchable by name and town/city.
