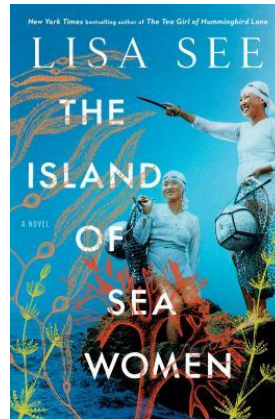
- Discover how to: Make healthy food choices and plan menus.

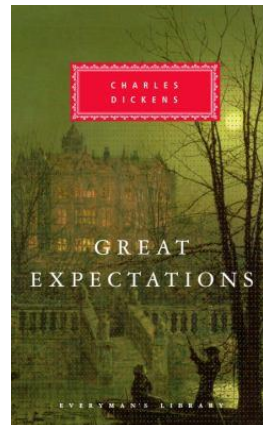

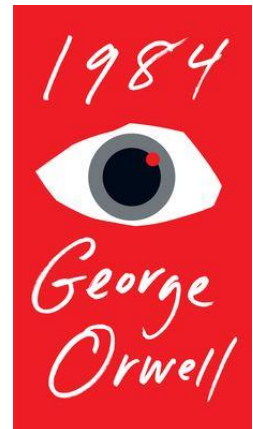
