To complete the reading challenge

Updated Library Card Applications and Policy Manual

Riverside Regional Library has updated its library application forms. On July 17, all library cards for patrons 17 and under expired. Parents or legal guardians of these patrons must come into the branch to complete and sign the new application forms for juvenile and youth patrons. Forms must be updated and signed before juvenile and youth patrons will be permitted to check out library materials.

The application form for adult patrons has also been updated and will be used for new patrons. Current adult (ages 18+) library card holders will not have to complete the new application form.

The library's policy manual has also been updated and this was approved by the Board of Trustees at its regular meeting in June. The policy manual and new application forms can be view on the library's website <https://riversideregionallibrary.org/board-policies/>

These actions were taken because of a rule changed at the Missouri State Library required by Secretary of State Rule 15 CSR 20-200.015 Library Certification Requirement for Protection of Minors.

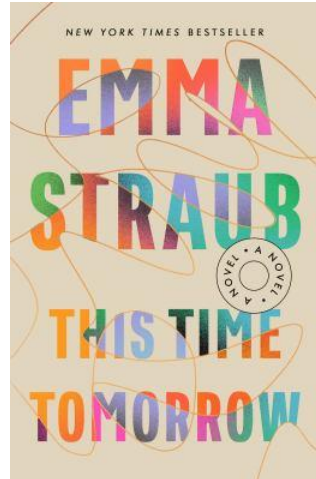

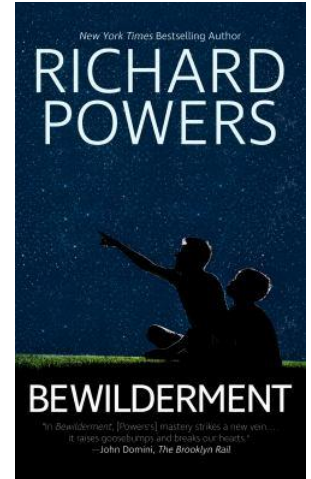
