

Friends of the Library Book Sale

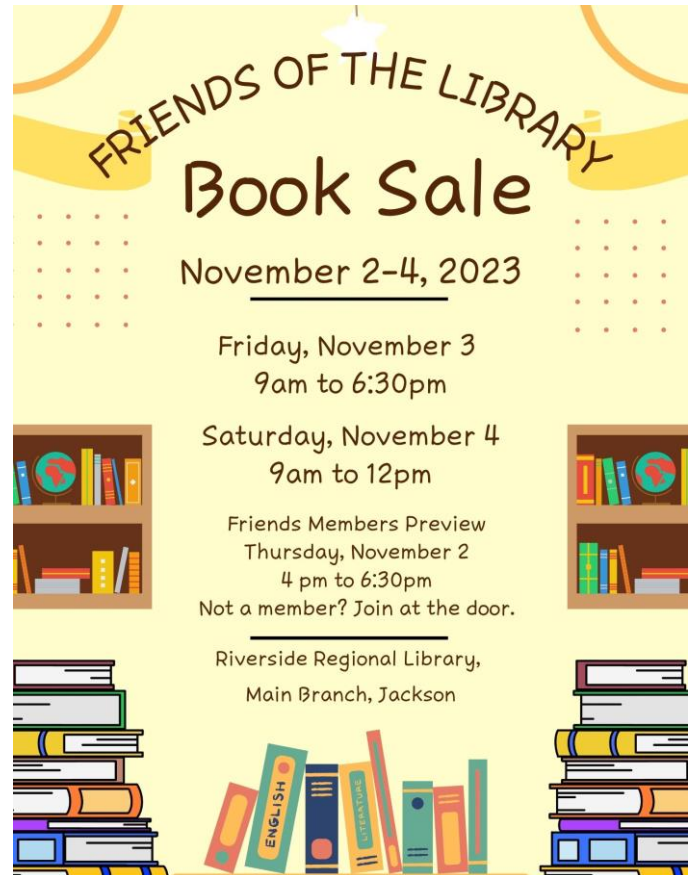
The Friends of the Library@Jackson will hold their Fall Book Sale on November 2 to 4. An amazing selection of books for all ages will be available for sale at incredible prices.

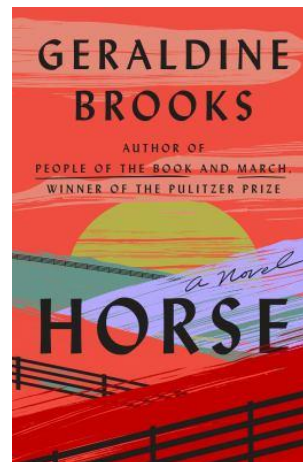

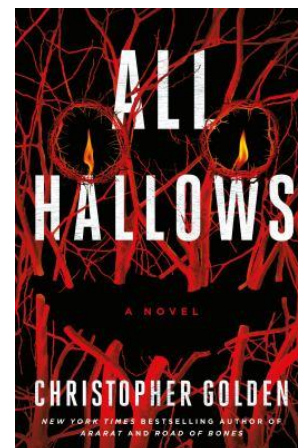
