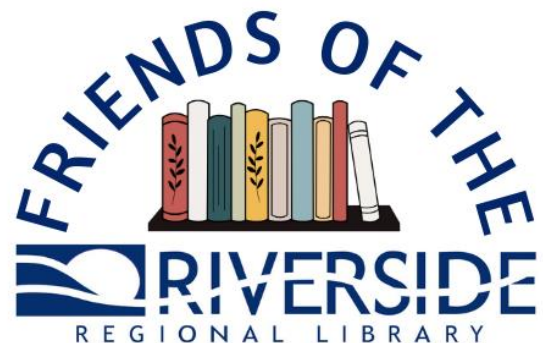

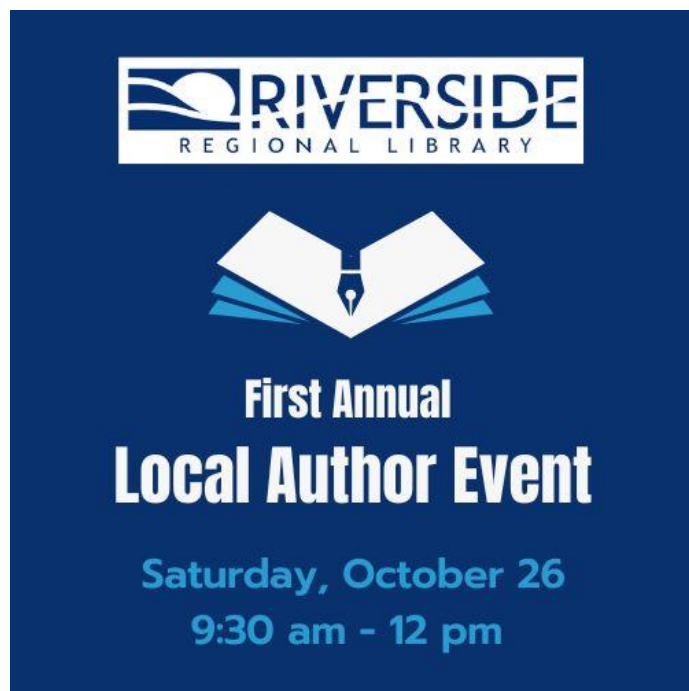
Notes from the Director's Desk

Missouri Evergreen App - 24/7 access to your library account!!!

Need to check when your book or DVD is due? Want to check if a book that was recommended to you or you saw on social media is available? Want to request and place a hold on a book? Then the Missouri Evergreen App is for you!!



The Evergreen app allows you to complete simple tasks related to your library account including

- See the list of items you have checked out AND renew them.
- Search for a book or DVDs AND place it on hold.
- Limit the search to your Riverside branch, any Riverside Library or all the libraries that are part of the Missouri Evergreen Consortium.
- Check the status of holds/requests.
- Check messages related to overdue books and when books you're requested become available.
- See the charges/fines on your account.
- Check the hours for your branch library and contact us!!
- Create and manage lists. Track an author or series you're reading or create a "To Be Read" list.

To get the Missouri Evergreen app, search your app store for "Missouri Evergreen" and download the app. Sign in using your library card number and PIN. If you don't have or remember your PIN, contact your library branch and the staff will create one for you. It's easy and very helpful. Try it today!!
